His major works introduced Hindu-Arabic numerals "0,1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9" and concept of Algebra into European mathematics $(a+b)^2=a^2+b^2+2ab$.

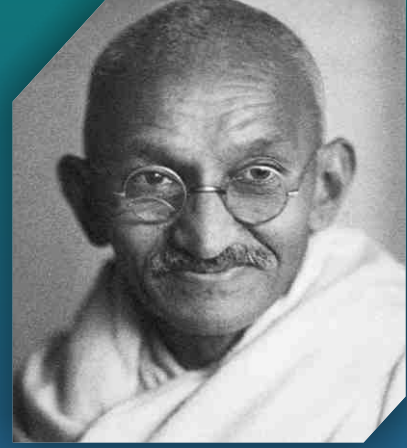

Importance of Education

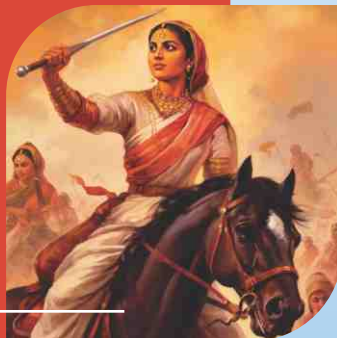

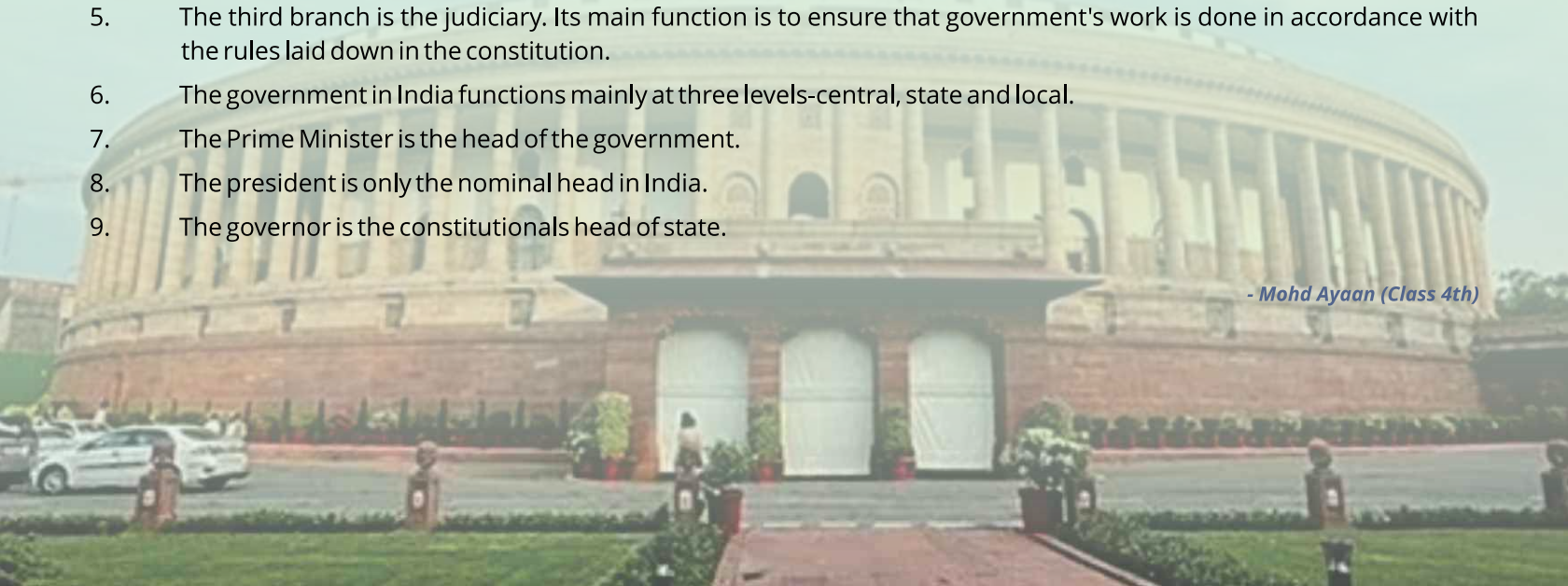

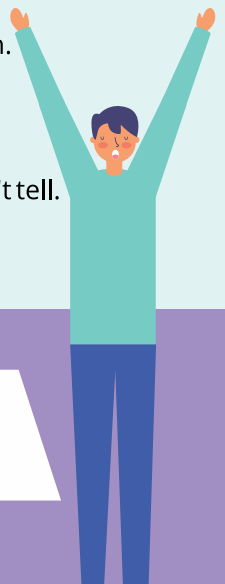
